Police and Municipal Police watch over the security in Wroclaw. You can always count on their help. While reporting a case, or during an intervention, you have to introduce yourself and to show the documents. Always carry your passport and/or residence card with you. In Poland, these documents confirm your identity.

Download a free application for smartphones "Moja Komenda" — a guide to Polish Police units prepared by the Ministry of Interior Affairs and Administration, and the Police. The app will show you the nearest Police unit with a phone number and it will lead you to it. The app includes phone numbers and email addresses to help you if you have a problem with your safety and public order at your place of residence.

In case of an emergency: If you are in danger or see a person in need (ex. victim of an accident, lost child, lying person etc.).

Police deals, among the others, with:

- helping crime victims,
- helping victims of violence, including domestic violence,
- prosecuting criminal offenders,
- ensuring security and public order.

If you have become a victim of crime, report it by phone or in person at a Police unit:

- Prepare your passport and/or residence card.
- Remember all the details of the incident and take the documents that may be helpful when reporting a crime.
- Prepare information about the witnesses of the event.
- Go to the nearest police station.



- At the police station officer will register your oral notification of suspicion of committing a criminal offense and will lecture you on your rights and obligations.
- If you do not speak Polish come with a trusted person who will help you communicate with the Police.
- If you need an interpreter, inform the officer beforehand, who will contact the interpreter and set an appointment.

You can report and describe places of particular danger on the National Map of Security Threats (Krajowa Mapa Zagrożeń Bezpieczeństwa), which is located as a bookmark on the police website.

Driving under the influence of alcohol is a misdemeanor or a criminal offense. If the blood alcohol content is between 0.2 and 0.5 ppm, the driver is punished by a fine or detention.

In case of higher alcohol content in the blood, the driver may go to jail, lose his driving license and pay a high fine.

If you have become a victim of hate speech, hate crime or other form of discrimination, you can report it to the Agent of the Voivodeship's Police Commander for Protection of Human Rights (Pełnomocnik Komendanta Wojewódzkiego Policji ds. Ochrony Praw Człowieka). pelnomocnikopc@wr.policja.gov.pl

- controlling traffic and ensuring its order.

Remember to:

park your vehicle in accordance with regulations

- do not park your car at places for disabled if you do not have a permit
- if you have a lock on the wheel of your car call **986**

take care of cleanliness and ecology

- segregate rubbish do not burn waste
- do not pollute public places
- clean up after your dog

do not drink alcohol and do not smoke in public places

- in trams and buses at tram and bus stops
- do not drink alcohol in the streets, sidewalks, squares, in parks
